di Rosa is a contemporary art museum with a large collection of Northern California artwork and a dynamic rotating exhibitions program. The Curatorial Intern will be an integral part of the planning and execution of our fall 2017 exhibitions, and will also have duties involving the care and maintenance of the collection. The Curatorial Intern will assist curatorial staff with research and development of our upcoming exhibitions. The intern will compile information and materials about the artists involved in the projects, communicate directly with artists when needed, and gathers support materials. The intern will also assist with simple data entry, document creation, and calendaring. Other duties may be assigned.

Volunteer interns must be able to work a minimum of 16 hours/week over the course of the semester, have excellent communication skills, be familiar with contemporary art practices, and have junior, senior or graduate-level status. This non-compensatory internship is appropriate for students from the following majors: museum studies, art history, curatorial studies. Academic credit can be arranged. Hours are flexible between 9 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday.
