



di Rosa | Collections Management Internship

di Rosa is a contemporary art museum with a large collection of Northern California artwork and a dynamic rotating exhibitions program. Collections management interns work closely with the Curatorial Department. The internship is designed to provide students with the opportunity to work on projects related to documenting the permanent collection, inventorying and cataloguing objects, assisting with incoming and outgoing loans, exhibitions, database management, and special projects related to the display, maintenance, and conservation of artwork. Interns will also work under the guidance of the Curatorial Staff to update and maintain permanent exhibits and interpretive material, as needed.

Volunteer interns must be able to work 12-16 hours/week over the course of the semester, be computer literate, and have junior, senior or graduate-level status. This non-compensatory internship is appropriate for students from the following majors: museum studies, art history, art, history, and library science. Academic credit can be arranged. Hours are flexible between 9 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday.
