di Rosa Center for Contemporary Art presents dynamic exhibitions and programs for all ages and houses the foremost collection of contemporary Bay Area art in the world. A wide range of styles, media, and subject matter provides an overview of the creative energy and freedom to experiment that characterize this region of California. di Rosa features three galleries, a sculpture park, and a 35-acre lake, all located on 217 scenic acres in Napa Valley's famed Carneros region. GALLERY 1 presents modern and contemporary artworks from the di Rosa collection curated by Bay Area writers, artists and thinkers along thematic lines. With views of Winery Lake, the gallery is where visitors check in for tours of the entire site.

GALLERY 2* (not pictured) features exhibitions of commissioned work by Bay Area artists and installations of collection artwork. *Note: Gallery 2 is closed through fall 2017 for renovations.*



The **RESIDENCE GALLERY*** offers a glimpse into a private collector's world. A Napa County Landmark, this 130-year-old three-story stone building originally housed a winery and later became the home of collectors Rene and Veronica di Rosa from 1960-1996. Today it houses hundreds of works from the di Rosa collection, shown salon-style in each room of the house.



The **SCULPTURE MEADOW*** is located on the north end of the property and stretches up to Milliken Peak, the highest summit in the Carneros region. A 1/3-mile trail winds past several dozen oversized outdoor sculptures. Access is restricted to the Outdoor Sculpture Tour (offered on the first Sunday of each month) and Nature Hikes to the top of Milliken Peak (offered May-October).

Hours: Wednesday-Sunday, 10 am-4 pm

Gallery 1 has a \$5 admission fee. The rest of the galleries and grounds are accessible by *guided tour only* (\$12, with discounts for seniors, students, and educators).

SPECIALTY TOURS

School Tours: Free school tours are offered for pre-K through Grade 12 students. Led by specially-trained docents, school tours conform to the California State Standards for Art and English Language Arts and are available throughout the year with a reservation.

Spanish Language Tours: Led by native Spanish-speaking docents, these tours are available for individuals and groups of up to 25 people with a reservation.

Private Tours: Private tours can be tailored to the needs and interests of your group, including picnics on the property and specially trained guides. Contact us for more information and rates.
