## Di Rosa Offers New Spanish Language Tours

NAPA, CA – January 12, 2011. Di Rosa introduces a pilot program of Spanish language tours beginning February 19. Tours of the di Rosa galleries and scenic property led by Spanish speaking guides will take place on Saturdays at 11:30 am on February 19, March 5 and 19, and April 9, 2011.

The tour will include the Gatehouse exhibition ***Surviving Paradise/Sobreviviendo el Paraíso***, a solo exhibition by renowned Bay Area artist Enrique Chagoya. The work highlights cross-border themes that Chagoya has explored throughout his artistic career, including immigration, colonization, political struggle, economics and cultural imposition.
