## *Di Rosa Gains New Board Members*

NAPA, CA – December, 2011. Di Rosa welcomes new board members Barbara Sandoval Terrazas and Jackie Jackson. Both women bring impressive credentials and share a passion for di Rosa’s mission to support the Bay Area’s art and artists.

**Barbara Sandoval Terrazas** has more than 30 years of experience in organizational development, strategic planning, governmental relations, grants administration, resource development, and community affairs.

She is the director of planning, development, and policy at Tiburcio Vasquez Health Center, one of the leaders in delivering culturally and linguistically appropriate health care services in Southern Alameda County. She was the CEO of Catholic Charities of Alameda/Contra Costa—the largest social service provider in the East Bay—for more than 10 years. Previously she was vice president of regional operations at “Just Say No” International, director of affiliate relations and planning for the American Lung Association of California (ALAC), and executive director for La Clinica de la Raza.

Terrazas has a B.A. in sociology from Mills College and earned her M.P.H. from UC Berkeley in 1976. She sits on the board of trustees for Mills College, the board of directors for CompassPoint, and the New American Community Foundation board. She lives in Alameda.

**Jackie Jackson** grew up in Oakland and graduated from UC Berkeley. After working in Human Resources and then real estate, Jackie dedicated herself to volunteering with the American Cancer Society. Moving around the U.S. she became active in arts organizations such as the Minneapolis Institute of Arts and the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago where she co-chaired their major fundraiser. Also in Chicago, Jackie served on the board of Art Resources in Teaching, a 100 year old organization providing free visual arts education in the Chicago Public Schools.

Since moving to Napa, Jackie has served as a board member of Music in the Vineyards where she developed and produced, along with a committee of dedicated volunteers, Kitchens in the Vineyards, the major fundraiser for Music in the Vineyards. Jackie has been a docent at di Rosa since 1998.
