Thank you for your interest in sharing your work with di Rosa. We do not currently have a call for entries for a specific project, although curatorial staff reviews submissions on a rolling basis. We are always interested in learning about new art. While we cannot meet with every interested artist personally, we archive submissions for up to two years for future reference.

To ensure that your work receives a fair review, we appreciate your attention to the following guidelines. Due to the volume of submissions, Curatorial staff will contact you only if they would like more information.

## ELIGIBILITY

di Rosa's exhibitions program currently focuses on the art and artists of Northern California. If you do not live or work in this geographic area, we cannot consider your work for exhibition.

#### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submissions are accepted via mail or email. No phone inquiries.

### Mail inquiries should be addressed to:

- Please include a CD/DVD or USB drive that includes the following:
  - An artist CV or resume that contains your contact information
  - An artist statement
  - No more than 25 images or video files
  - A list of submitted artwork and media
- If you prefer to send in printed materials, please use plain envelopes and paper. We do not accept slides. Fancy/bulky portfolios, binders, sheet protectors or report covers will be discarded.
- DO NOT send original artwork, irreplaceable catalogs/publications, or anything that you need returned to you. Materials submitted will not be returned, and we are not responsible for lost or damaged materials.

**Email inquiries** should be addressed to curatorial@dirosaart.org with the subject line "Artist Submission" and should include the following:

- Links to and descriptions of your work should in the body of the email. **Do not submit** artwork files as attachments.
- Please include a CV or resume and an artist statement as a pdf attachment
- Do not send any other attachments.
